INTENT: REQUEST TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OR LONG-TERM LEASE FROM LANGLADE COUNTY TO THE TOWN OF NORWOOD OF PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS LOTS 1, 2, 3, & 4 of certified survey Vol.20 Pg.143, recorded as document number 469333 dated 31 July 2023 FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A PARK.


WHEREAS, Langlade County is the fee-simple owner of four lots described as LOTS, 1, 2, 3, & 4 of certified survey Vol.20 Pg.143, recorded as document number 469333 dated 31 July 2023; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2023 Langlade Resolution #33-2023 failed to pass and these lands were not offered for sale and the recommendation was to have the County Forest Administrator and County Administrator work with the Town of Norwood and the Friends of The Moose Lake association to discuss whether either party was interested in purchasing said parcels; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Norwood and the Friends of Moose Lake are interested in maintaining the said property as a public place, protected from residential development; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Norwood is interested in purchasing or acquiring a long-term lease of said lands for development of a park with cost of development and perpetual maintenance of the park to be paid by the Town of Norwood with assistance of grants, partners, and groups that may assist in that development; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Norwood Board of Supervisors hereby request action of the Langlade County Board of Supervisors to identify methods by which the Town could purchase or establish a long term lease on County land described as LOTS, 1, 2, 3, & 4 of certified survey Vol.20 Pg.143, recorded as document number 469333 dated 31 July 2023 to be retained as a public place with future investment by the Town and partner organizations for development and perpetual maintenance of a public park.


