



**PERMIT TO CUT FIREWOOD ON LANGLADE
COUNTY-OWNED LAND
FOR PERSONAL USE**

Under this permit issued by the LANGLADE County Forestry, Recreation and Land Department, Permission is granted to Permittee to cut up to 10 face cords of firewood for personal use upon the LANGLADE County Forest until expiration of: _____ (expiration date)

Cutting of firewood means the gathering/cutting of down trees for heating purposes under the following conditions:

1. This permit must be in immediate possession of the permittee when in the process of cutting, taking, and/or transporting firewood from the forest.
2. Firewood cutting is only authorized on County owned lands in the sections described above. Permittee assumes all responsibility for the location of cutting and is subject to the penalty provided by statute and ordinances for any cutting outside of the above descriptions.
3. Permit is for cutting firewood for the personal use of the permittee at their immediate household or seasonal dwelling. Cutting of firewood for commercial sale is not allowed under this permit.
4. Permittee shall use all possible care in the removal of downed trees to prevent the injury of remaining green trees, including saplings. Permittee will be subject to penalty provided by statutes and ordinances for unauthorized cutting of green or standing trees.
5. No firewood cutting is allowed within active logging job areas or from piles cut by loggers. Permittee may be subject to penalty provided by statute for timber theft.
6. Tops or branches **shall not** be left on roads, ditches, trails or within lakes or streams.
7. Permittee retains all responsibility for knowing the property ownership prior to cutting of firewood under this permit.
8. Vehicles utilized for firewood collection must remain on roads and trails authorized for motorized vehicle use. Permittee shall be liable for damage to forest roads and trails.
9. Permittee agrees to comply with all State and Federal regulations and County Ordinances regarding slash, fire, litter and motor vehicle policies.
10. Failure to comply with conditions of this permit may result in permit revocation and/or prosecution of the Permittee for Forest Products Theft.
11. Permittee agrees that LANGLADE County or any County Contractor, including logging contractors, cannot be held liable for injuries or accidents resulting from any permittee actions or omissions under this permit. Permittee assumes and agrees to protect, indemnify, and save harmless the Owner (Langlade County), its representatives, agents, officers, and employees from and against any and all claims, demands, suits, causes of action, liability, costs, or expense by reason of loss or damage to any property or bodily injury to any person, including death, as the direct or indirect result of operations under this permit or in connection with any action or omission of the Permittee, who shall defend the Owner, its representatives, agents, officers and employees in any such cause of action, claim or suit.

This permit shall become effective upon receipt of \$25.00 fee in cash or check and signature approval of authorized representatives of the Langlade County Forestry, Parks and Recreation Department.
