

DISPERSED CAMPING

Winter, Spring, Summer or Fall!

Camping in undeveloped areas of the Langlade County Forest is authorized. Dispersed camping within ¼ mile of any developed recreational facility or park is not allowed.

Occupancy and dispersed camping on County lands by any person shall not exceed 14 consecutive days, regardless of location.

Dispersed camping by groups of 6 or more people require a special use permit issued by the Department.

JACK LAKE RECREATION AREA

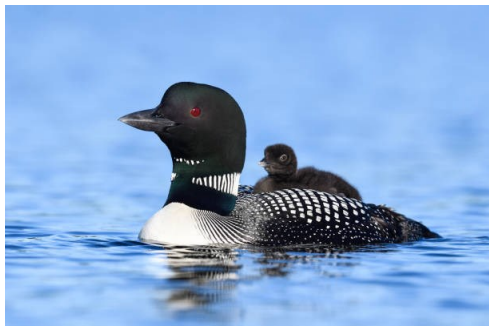
Veteran's Memorial Park is the highlight of the recreation area including:

- Sandy Beach with crystal clear waters for swimming.
- 21-hole Disc Golf Course.
- Picnic area and Playground.
- Hiking and Mountain bike trails.
- Nature trail and arboretum.
- Access to the Ice Age Trail.

Jack Lake Campground is adjacent to the park with its relaxing, beautiful setting alongside Jack Lake.

The campground consists of 48 RV/ Tent sites, 30 amp electrical service, a non-electric one group site and three sleeping cabins. Amenities include two flush restroom facilities, 4 private, coin-operated showers, RV dump and fill station, and solid waste and recycling center. Wood and ice are available for purchase.

Also within the Jack Lake Recreation Area, a few miles south of Veteran's Memorial Park, is **High Lake Campground**. High Lake provides a more rustic camping experience consisting of 5 hike-in campsites. Campsites vary from just a couple feet from the parking area to roughly half a mile from the parking area.

The sites are all located along High Lake, a beautiful, undeveloped lake, is perfect for boating or fishing! Vaulted restrooms and fresh water are available on-site.

There is also a small, primitive boat landing available for smaller boats and access to adjacent mountain bike and hiking trails.

CHARLES DE LANGLADE RECREATION AREA

Perch Lake Campground is the highlight of this recreation area. The campground is nestled between two quiet, pristine lakes, towering oak and pine trees and an abundance of wildlife. Constructed in 2023, the campground consists of 57 sites varying from a group site, a double site, tent sites, lake sites, back-in sites and pull-through sites!

Amenities include private flush restrooms with showers, vault restrooms throughout, drinking water within a short walking distance from each site, handicap accessible sites, an RV dump and fill station and solid waste and recycling center. No electrical service is available; however, generators are permitted with conditions as outlined in the campground policies.

Access to Anninan and Perch Lakes are adjacent to the campground. The campground is also located less than 4 miles from Upper and Lower Post Lake and access via hiking trails to the Wolf River.

Perch Lake Campground is ATV/UTV friendly. The campground provides access via road routes to ATV/UTV trail systems linking to all of Northeast Wisconsin.
