## SUMMIT LAKE COUNTY PARK POLICIES

Park Hours: 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM

Park Entry: There is no charge for entering the park.

Public Beach Area: No life guard on duty, swim at your own risk. No smoking in swimming beach area.

Picnic Areas: Grills are permitted but not provided. All trash must be deposited into trash receptacles.

Parking Area: All motorized vehicles must remain in the designated parking area.

Fishing: Fishing is allowed on all public piers and shorelines with appropriate fishing license. Fishing is not allowed in designated swimming areas. Please review local bag limits before fishing. We do not sell fishing licenses or bait.

Pets: Pets are not allowed in any area of the park, this includes: beach areas, picnic areas, pavilions, playgrounds and park restrooms.

Garbage Receptacles: Please respect the land and throw your litter in a garbage receptacle. Trash receptacles are intended for park users ONLY.

Campfires: Campfires are not allowed unless there is a designated campfire pit or use of fire in a park grill.

Camping: Overnight camping is not permitted at this county park.

Use of fireworks and firearms are prohibited.

Personal Conduct: No person shall engage in violent, abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud or otherwise disorderly conduct. Complaints received about visitors and confirmed by department staff may be evicted from park and fined.

Wildlife: Keep wildlife wild! There will be critters present, please do not disturb, harass or feed the wildlife.

Pavilion Reservations: The open-air pavilion is available for use on a first come, first serve basis or by reservation. Please call 715.627.6300 to reserve. If the shelter is marked with a yellow "reserve" tag, you may not occupy it. The pavilion includes electrical service, trash receptacles, park grill and 6-8 picnic tables for seating. Vehicles must park in the designated parking lot. Parties must be vacated by 10:00 pm, unless prior arrangements are made with department staff. No pets are allowed at shelters or anywhere in the park. You are responsible for informing all members of your party that pets are not allowed.
