TOWN OF WOLF RIVER
ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ORDINANCE 2009-01

A Sole Ordinance to regulate the Use and Operation of All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV's) in the Town of Wolf River, Langlade County and for the purpose of establishing a designated route.

Section I – Intent

The Town of Wolf River adopts the following all-terrain vehicle (ATV) ordinance/route for operation of all-terrains vehicles (ATV) upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weights against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this ordinance has been created.

Section II – Statutory Authority

This route is created pursuant to the Town of Wolf River authority under Section 60.01 as authorized by Section 23.33(8) (b), Wis. Stats.

Optional – the provisions of 23.33 are adopted.

Section III – Routes

The following roads are designated as routes:

The Town of Wolf River in Langlade County adopts the following roads for travel for all-terrain vehicles:

Diamond Roof Road
Mary Lake Lane
Rose Lake Road
Sawyer Lake Road
Setting Lake Road

NOTE: The Town of Wolf River does not intend to open up all town roads for ATV Travel.

Section IV – Conditions

As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers where applicable):

- A. All all-terrain vehicle (ATV) operators must have their head lights on at all times.
- B. All al-terrain vehicle (ATV) operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits which are 20 mph.
- C. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR64.12 and NR64.127)

- D. All all-terrain vehicle (ATV) operators shall ride single file.
- E. All all-terrain vehicles (ATV) must travel on the extreme right of the roads.
- F. Speed limits of 10 mph must be observed when within 150 feet of a residence or within 100 feet of other users on the roadway as in bicyclist, pedestrians, etc.
- G. Anyone born on or after 1/1/1988 is required to have a DNR safety certificate.
- H. All persons under the age of 18 operating and/or riding an all-terrain vehicle (ATV) must wear a helmet.
- I. All-terrain vehicles (ATV) must display current registration decals or a valid registration renewal receipt.
- J. Days of Operation: May 1st through November 1st, or as otherwise posted.

Section V – Enforcement

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of Langlade County, Wisconsin and the State of Wisconsin.

Section VI – Penalties

Wisconsin State All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) Penalties as found in s.23.33 (13) (a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.


Section VII – Severability

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town would have passed the other provisions of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other person's circumstances shall not be deemed affected.


THE TOWN OF WOLF RIVER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CLOSE ANY AND ALL ROUTES DUE TO FAILURE OF ATV RIDER(S) TO OBEY THE TERMS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Section VIII – Effective Date


This ordinance becomes effective upon publication and posting of roadway signs.
